## September News Update

Over the past 12 months we have been developing a project to improve our heating system and also to make it more environmentally sustainable and economic to run. This has involved quite a bit of research and form filling to obtain the grants to enable us to begin the planned changes.

This week the proposals have been discussed and agreed by the Community Centre Trustees and the work will now begin. Our hope is to have improved our present system by the end of October (before the winter weather begins!).

Thanks to a grant from Burnham and Weston Energy we have already been able to complete the upgrade of the Centre lighting to LED fittings which will help reduce our electricity bill. Our corridors now have automatic switches which work when movement is detected.



We have also just received a grants to upgrade our door access system to be automatic opening and closing, This will be a much needed improvement making it easier for people to enter and leave the building. We are very grateful to the Bernard Sunley Foundation for providing the funding to enable us to do this. This has now been commissioned and should be completed in the ne



The new heating system will control each room independently, ensuring they have an optimum temperature when they are in use. Our 6 main rooms will also have infrared heating panels installed on the ceiling and a solar panel system will eventually be put on the roof.
